## Ependymoma Outcomes Survey Announcement

***The Collaborative Ependymoma Research Network (CERN) Foundation expands survey of people living with ependymoma to include children and their parents***

CERN is a foundation whose mission is to develop new treatments for ependymoma thereby improving the outcomes and care of patients and ultimately leading to a cure.

The Ependymoma Outcomes (EO) Projects are online questionnaires designed to gather information to better understand outcomes for people living with ependymoma.

Key objectives of the EO Project are to:

- Gather information on the treatment strategies and health status of patients with ependymoma;
- Disseminate information to health care providers on the symptoms, treatment and outcomes of patients with ependymoma to improve their practices;
- Publish objective data on trends and regional differences in the care of patients with ependymoma, with the goal to improve and standardize care; and
- Develop ideas based on this data for future clinical trials to improve survival and the health status of people with ependymoma.

Initially this project was limited to adults, but has now expanded to include children (less than 18 years of age) and their parents or proxy (the Pediatric Ependymoma Outcomes Project or PEO). Participants will be anonymous and will provide information on their current health status and treatment history. Your participation will help us identify unique trends and potential way of improving the care of ependymoma patients.
